What personal information do we collect?

We only collect the minimum amount of information that is relevant to the purpose. If you interact with us on the internet, the personal information we collect depends on whether you just visit our website or, use our services. If you visit our website, your browser transmits some data automatically, such as your browsing times, the data transmitted and your IP address. If you use our services, personal information is required to fulfill the requirements of that service. Generally, we collect the following personal information. If there is any specific personal information to collect, we will indicate as such, at or near the time of collection:

- Physical address
- Identification Number
- Telephone number
- Email address
- Financial & banking details
- Name, together with other identifying information

Who might we share your personal information with?

To maintain and improve our services, your personal information may need to be shared with or disclosed to our service providers, other organisations such as ours or, in some cases, public or legal authorities.

We may disclose your personal information to our suppliers or service providers who are involved in the specified processing purpose. We have agreements in place to ensure that they comply with the privacy requirements as required by POPIA (Protection of Personal Information Act) and GDPR.

We may also disclose your information:

- Where we have a duty or a right to disclose in terms of law or industry codes; or
- Where we believe it is necessary to protect our rights
